# September 2017 Public Employees Federation (PEF) Performance Advances Updates for Pay Basis 21P and Calendar (CAL) Teachers

**August 23, 2017**

The Office of the State Comptroller (OSC) recently released [Payroll Bulletin #1582](#) regarding the September 2017 Performance Advances Updates for Pay Bases 21P and CAL teachers. **The September 2017 Performance Advances will be paid in the paychecks dated September 20, 2017 (Administration) or September 28, 2017 (Institutional).**

The following are details regarding payment dates and eligibility criteria for these performance advances. Your bargaining unit information can be found on the front of your pay stub under “Negotiating Unit.”

Calendar (CAL) and 21P (21 Pay Period) Teachers in graded positions (Grades 001-037) and NS positions (Grade 600) which are equated to a grade (Grade 001-037) must also meet the criteria below:

- Annual salary is below the Job Rate of the employee’s grade on the payment effective date (CAL – payment effective date 9/1/17) (21P – The Contract Begin Date based on the Department)
- Has completed 150 workdays in such grade during the rating cycle for the 2016-2017 academic year
- Has a Pay Basis Code of 21P or CAL on the appropriate payment effective date (CAL 9/1/17) and (21P the Contract Begin Date based on the Department)
- Was rated at least “Satisfactory” or its equivalent on their last rating date
- Active on the State Payroll or are on a Leave with Pay on the payment effective date

Please note: Employees who would have been eligible to receive the September 2017 Performance Advance, but were promoted to a higher grade in any bargaining unit prior to September 2017 may be eligible for a revised promotion salary (promotion recalculation) provided the employee is not eligible for a performance advance in the higher grade.
