## Summer Camps at NYS Worksite Child Care Centers

Now is the time of year when parents are making plans to enroll their children in summer day camps. There are a number of NYS worksite child care centers that provide full-day summer camp programs for children ages 5 to 12.

If you are not already enrolled in the DCAAccount and you plan to send your children under the age of 13 to a summer day camp, you may want to consider enrolling in the Dependent Care Advantage Account (DCAAccount). Visit [www.flexspend.ny.gov](http://www.flexspend.ny.gov) or call 1-800-358-7202 and choose option 2 to talk with a Customer Service Representative about your eligibility for the employer contribution and how this valuable, money-saving benefit could help you with camp expenses.
